Shropshire Rural Housing connect retrofits & new builds to micro ground source heat network

Shropshire Rural Housing Association (SRHA) has adopted Kensa Heat Pumps' micro ground source heat network design to roll out installations in both their retrofit and new build housing stock on one site; it is the first time the system has been employed on one site covering both existing and new builds. The residents benefit from up to 50% running cost savings and significant improvements in comfort and control, while SRHA benefits from low lifetime ownership cost and RHI income.

Shropshire Rural Housing Association has shown how micro ground source heat network systems can alleviate high heating bills and asset management costs in both existing and new build social housing stock.
